Starts will be broadcast on VHF73 in 3-minute intervals. Start Line:

A line from the flagpole, in the vicinity of the Dinah Beach Trailer on Stokes Hill Wharf to the start buoy anchored approximately 250m off.

Finish Line: IN AN EAST – WEST DIRECTION

A line from the flagpole, in the vicinity of the Dinah Beach Trailer on Stokes Hill Wharf to the **START BUOY ANCHORED APPROX 250M OFF, with the wharf on your starboard side.**

Race Frequency VHF CH73, OOD and Recalls ODD Mobile: 0407 476 579 - Sharelle Peek

Recalls: Any yacht crossing the start line prematurely may be called on VHF **Channel 73** and that vessel must return and restart.

Nominated Skippers MUST be a financial Senior Member of the Association and must abide by item 1.02 of the *Special Regulations for Racing Boats*.

1.02 RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PERSON IN CHARGE

The safety of a boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the person in charge who must do their best to ensure the boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by an experienced crew who have undergone appropriate training and are physically fit to face bad weather. He must be satisfied as to the soundness of hull, spars, rigging, sails and all gear. He must ensure all safety equipment is properly maintained and stowed and the crew know where it is kept and how to use it.
