## **SHIPPING** (at time of printing)

#### **Start Line:**

A line from the flagpole, in the vicinity of the Dinah Beach Trailer on Stokes Hill Wharf to the start buoy anchored approximately 250m off.

#### **Finish Line:**

A line from the flagpole, in the vicinity of the Dinah Beach Trailer on Stokes Hill Wharf to the green buoy #15, with the Wharf on your port side.

Nominated Skippers MUST be a financial Full Member of the Association and must abide by item 1.02 of the *Special Regulations for Racing Boats*.

#### 1.02 RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PERSON IN CHARGE

The safety of a boat and her crew is the sole and inescapable responsibility of the person in charge who must do their best to ensure the boat is fully found, thoroughly seaworthy and manned by an experienced crew who have undergone appropriate training and are physically fit to face bad weather. He must be satisfied as to the soundness of hull, spars, rigging, sails and all gear. He must ensure all safety equipment is properly maintained and stowed and the crew know where it is kept and how to use it.
