The Tiwi Islands Yacht Race 2019 – Racing Instructions

1. Rules

The Tiwi Islands Yacht Race will be governed by the rules, as defined in

1. Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)
2. Current IRC Rules Parts A, B & C where applicable (Div1)
3. Australian Sailing Special Regulations Safety Category 3 PLUS
4. International Rules for Prevention of Collision at Sea (IRPCS) at night
5. Racing Instructions
6. Notice of Race

2. Divisions

Division 1 – ORC Club Monohull

ORC Certificate & Cat 3 PLUS Life Raft & Sat Phone.

Division 1 – PHS Monohull

PHS Handicap & Cat 3 PLUS Life Raft & Sat Phone

Division 2 - PHS Multihull

PHS Handicap & Cat 3 PLUS Life Raft & Sat Phone.

3. Safety Requirements

All yachts will require Australian Sailing Special Regulations Safety Category 3 plus;

- A Life Raft(s) that has been serviced within the last 3 years, capable of carrying the entire crew in the case of a vessel abandonment.
- Satellite Phone Communication.

4. The Race

Start: Saturday 8 June 2019 at 09:00 with communications on VHF Channel 73.

Course: Anticlockwise circumnavigation of the Tiwi Islands keeping the Islands to Port.

Start Line: Between a Flag at East Point and O Buoy.

East Point: 12°24.48'S, 130°48.95'E. O Buoy: 12°24.30'S, 130°48.24'E.

Finish Line: Between Dudley Point and E Buoy. **Yachts to take their own finish time.**

Dudley Point: 12°24.90'S, 130°49.10'E. E Buoy 12°25.56'S 130°48.80'E.

Finish time must be emailed to bob@coltech.com.au by 16:00 Tuesday 11 June

08:56 4 Minutes Warning on Channel 73

08:59 1 Minutes Warning on Channel 73

09:00 Warning on Channel 73 - All Divisions Start

Yachts starting early shall be recalled on Channel 73 and must restart by dipping the startline.
